**JOB PURPOSE:** The AutoCAD Specialist is to develop and prepare preliminary sketches, drafting, concept designs, layouts and drawings using Autodesk Computer Aided Design (AutoCAD) for the MPWIU-Project Management Unit

#### **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Prepare complete drawing sets for inclusion in tender documents.
- 2. Support land planning and infrastructure layout.
- 3. Provide accurate preliminary drawings for estimating purposes.
- 4. Produce and review as-built drawings for government facilities.
- 5. Conduct site visits and document existing conditions.
- 6. Standardize AutoCAD drawing formats and train local draftsmen.

# MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1 Responsible for the production of preliminary floor plans, drawings, project concepts, and preparation of construction drawings and details assigned by the Project Manager.
- 2.1 Assist MPWIU Land & Surveys in creating survey maps, layouts, and site development plans.
- 3.1 Assists the PMU-Quantity Surveyor/Cost Estimator by providing preliminary drawings, for bill of quantities and cost estimates purposes, and other specific related works assigned by the PMU Project Manager.
- 3.2 Collaborate on project costing and documentation.
- 4.1 Produce as-built drawings of government facilities (if required) that are planned for repairs or renovations and review as-built drawings submitted by the Contractors.

- 5.1 Assists the PMU Inspectors in conducting assessments on existing schools, health centers and other Government facilities planned for repairs and maintenance
- 6.1 Standardize AutoCAD drawings (e.g. pen assignments, texts, title blocks, details, etc), for all drawings produced by MPWIU and conduct trainings to all Local Draftsmen.
- 7.1 Perform other tasks as directed by the PMU Manager and MPWIU
