JOB PURPOSE: The incumbent will undergo formal training and obtain all three required Weather Service Observation Certifications. Upon certification, the incumbent will perform specialized technical work involving the observation, analysis, and interpretation of weather and atmospheric conditions and their effects on the atmosphere and the Earth's surface

- 3.2 Communicate meteorological information effectively, both orally and in writing, to the general public and specialized user groups
