JOB PURPOSE: Responsible for the safe and efficient operation of various light-duty motorized equipment for construction, maintenance, or material handling tasks, along with routine equipment upkeep and general manual labor.

 - Roadway patching.
 - Grounds and park maintenance, such as mowing, trimming trees, and general cleanup.
 - Assisting with utility system repairs (e.g., pipe laying, sewer cleaning).
 - Site preparation, including digging, grading, and landscaping.

- 3.1 Performing daily pre-operation safety checks, routine maintenance, and minor repairs on assigned equipment, including lubricating, fueling, and cleaning.
- 4.1 Adhering to all safety rules, guidelines, and traffic laws, and setting up work-site safety measures like barricades and cones.
- 5.1 Maintaining accurate daily logs and reports of work performed, materials used, and equipment status or malfunctions.
- 6.1 performing general manual labor tasks when not operating equipment, such as using hand and power tools (shovels, rakes, saws, jackhammers).
- 7.1 Perform other duties assigned
