JOB PURPOSE: Directing a comprehensive Public Health Medical/ Clinical program. Provides medical oversight of the RMI's Health Protection programs.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Establishes community health care policy
- 2. Provides clinical supervision of PH physicians, and Mid Care Level Providers, Program Clinical Advisers.
- 3. Examines and treats patients
- 4. Perform other duties within the capacity, qualification and experience normally expected from person occupying position as this classification

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- **1.1 Interfaces** with and acts as the departmental liaison to the private and non-profit health care sectors, explaining the department's functions and operations, directing department resources, and coordinating department response to meet community needs.
- **1.2** By maintaining ties with the local medical community, encouraging private physicians And allied health professionals to continue to provide contracted healthcare services to the department's clients
- **2.1** Formulates policy regarding what medical services the department will provide; ensure that clinical practices are uniform and up to date; independently or in consultation with MOHHS Minister's Leadership Team (MLT), interprets laws regarding medical treatment and provision of services; advised Medical Services Manager in clinical planning, assessing facility and equipment needs, and coordinating patient processing.

- **2.2** Serve as the EPiNet Chair in organizing respond measures in any uprising public health Emergencies or disease outbreaks from the MoHHS Surveillance network
- 3.1 Works with the RMI MOHHS Licensure Committee on peer review panels of physicians and allied health professionals employed by our contract to the RMI MOHHS; obtains information from clinical coordinators/mangers regarding performance of PHC-Employed physicians in non-medical areas and counsel's physicians to ensure that they observe performance standards and patient rights; takes disciplinary action against PHC-employed physicians for poor professional performance, violations of professional's ethics, etc; evaluates information obtained from hospital peer review of contract physicians; ensure that physicians are in good standing at hospital, PH Clinic, Mobile Clinic, Community outreach; reviews physician's charts to determine whether they are keeping problemoriented medical records; perform annual evaluation and assessment to the contract of physician or other health professional
- **4.1** Conduct medical examinations; collects, evaluates, and analyzes subjective and objective medical data; makes diagnoses, formulates treatment plans, prescribes medication or therapy, and determines need for further or specialized treatment; confers with patient's relatives regarding nature of patients' illness and recommended treatment.

DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS:

Qualification:

- Possession of a valid license as a Community Health Physician, or equivalent to a community health, medicine and surgeon issued by recognized institution
- Four years of any combination of experience as a public health physician and primary care physicians; and one year of administrative experience in medical services or programs that included supervision of physicians, prioritization of services and development of policies; or,
- A combination of training, education, and experience that would provide the required knowledge and abilities, and a license

Additional Qualifications: Possession of a valid RMI Medical Practitioner License

Knowledge of terminology of modern medicine; clinical medicine, including emergencies, primary care, and specialty medicine, accepted clinical practices; public health administration; basic budgeting; medical ethics.

Ability to organize and prioritize work; analyze and evaluate data, draw conclusion, and develop responses; learn, interpret, and apply laws and regulations pertaining to public health and PHC medical services; exercise independent judgement; establish and maintain working relationships with health care professionals and others; provide clinical direction and training to physicians and allied health professionals; establish standards and evaluate performance; communicate technical information to persons with carrying degrees of medical knowledge;

prepare a variety of write documents and reports; learn departmental operations and services; allocate resources; maintain objectivity.
