JOB PURPOSE: To provide health education to the public

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Provide health education to the patients and the community

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1 Develops health educational materials that are necessary for community outreach, training and, public information on health issues identified by the Ministry for preventive measures, writing scripts and recording of scripts for the development of programs, radio sports and television programs
- 1.2 Visit hospital wards, outpatient clinics, public health clinics to conduct health education on nutrition presentations to patients; conduct home visit and outreach activities with health teams and nurses in the Majuro Zones and to outer islands.
- 2.1 Conduct weekly health education radio program with other staff in the Division of HP&HD; writing articles on health issues for the weekly newspaper and the Ministry's quarterly newsletter; provides counseling services to patients that are referred to the Health Promotions Unit by medical staff and conduct follow-up with patients when necessary
- 3.1 Writing required reports for the health educational programs and activities and submitting to the supervisor as required; coordinates with other program areas within the Ministry of Health on

program activities, development of necessary educational materials, major health events and special projects that are implemented to assess the health programs and services in the RMI.
