JOB PURPOSE: Nursery Worker will work under the overall guidance of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Commerce and under the direct supervision of the Chief of Agriculture. The incumbent will work in close consultation and coordination with the RMI Government in carrying out his/her tasks and duties.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Nursery Operations and Plant Propagations
2. Plant Protection & Household Advisory
3. Administration and Operational Compliance

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1 Clean, measure, and mark out seedbeds and rows to ensure optimized crop spacing and maximum soil usage
- 1.2 Collect organic waste, manage turning cycles, and check moisture levels to maintain a high-yielding nursery composting facility
- 1.3 Blend precise portions of topsoil, sand, and organic matter to create consistent potting mixes for fragile seedlings
- 2.1 Perform physical walk-throughs of the nursery grounds every morning to check leaves and stems for signs of insects or blight
- 2.2 Mix and safely apply organic or chemical treatments to infected flora in strict compliance with safety guidelines
- 2.3 Conduct direct consultations with local community members to demonstrate proper seedling potting and soil management techniques
- 3.1 Maintain a clean daily logbook tracking seedling counts, batch distribution numbers, and fertilizer inventory usage
- 3.2 Draft a structured progress summary on the last week of every month for review by the Chief of Agriculture
