JOB PURPOSE: Build work relationships, solve problems, and support patients to learn self-navigation and get timely care; help coordinate patient care, connect patients with resources, and help patients understand the healthcare system. The Nurse Patient Navigator in Majuro will also conduct evaluation activities as part of training from the Evaluation Consultant.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Patient Support and Advocacy
2. Logistical & Administration Support
3. Connecting Patients with Services
4. Care Coordination
5. Program Monitoring and Reporting
6. Perform other duties within the capacity, qualification and experience normally expected from person occupying a position as this classification.

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1 Support patients to learn self-navigation.
- 1.2 Work closely with healthcare providers to ensure that services are provided to patients.
- 1.3 Advocate for clients/patients and help them understand the healthcare system.
- 2.1 Evaluation report for screening programs.
- 2.2 Implement the Navigation and Screening Plan activities.
- 2.3 Evaluate the Navigation and Screening Plan activities.

- 2.4 Make sure navigation and screening data are accurate and complete
- 2.5 Assist in ensuring of program database is updated and correct.
- 3.1 Establish relationships with public health, physicians, healthcare providers, community-based organizations, patient navigators, healthcare systems/clinics, and other referral networks to enhance NBCCEDP and screening programs.
- 3.2 Linking patients to healthcare providers, support groups, and community resources.
- 4.1 Coordinate patient appointments, diagnostic tests, and follow-up care to ensure continuity and smooth access to services across healthcare providers and facilities.
- 5.1 Prepare and submit reports on screening programs, patient navigation activities, and related services.
- 5.2 Assist in the evaluation of health programs and screening activities.
- 6.1 Ability to assist in any outlined work distributed by the Director of NBCCEDP Program.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor degree in Nursing or minimum of Certificate or Associate Degree in Nursing from a recognized institution
- At least 1–2 years of relevant nursing or public health experience, preferably in community health, patient education, or care coordination
- Experience working with screening programs, chronic disease management, or maternal and child health programs is an advantage

Skills:

- Clinical knowledge relevant to nursing practice and preventive health services.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills in English and Marshallese.
- Ability to work effectively with patients from diverse cultural and social backgrounds.
- Demonstrated skills in patient advocacy, care coordination, and problem-solving.
- Basic monitoring and evaluation skills, including data collection and reporting.
- Proficiency in computer applications such as Microsoft Word and Excel and basic patient care or health information systems.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a multidisciplinary team


