JOB PURPOSE: The Security Guard will be responsible for ensuring that the Laura Farm buildings, equipment, vehicle and surrounding premises are well-guarded and secured from any outside disturbance.

3. Systems Maintenance
4. Incident Escalation
5. Documentation Logs
6. Operational Flexibility

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1 Conduct continuous physical security patrols across the Laura Farm property throughout the shift to deter, identify, and remove unauthorized trespassers
- 2.1 Ensure all institutional tools, vehicles, and equipment are securely stored and locked inside designated storage facilities daily by 5:00 PM
- 3.1 Perform routine monitoring and testing of building controls and alarm systems to guarantee constant operational readiness
- 4.1 Report all site occurrences, safety hazards, and property breaches directly and immediately to the Chief of Administration or Deputy Secretary
- 5.1 Maintain accurate logs by recording daily observations, interviewing incident witnesses, and securing necessary signatures on security forms
- 6.1 Execute additional official security duties and administrative tasks as assigned by the Secretary or Deputy Secretary of NRC

- Graduation from an accredited high school or possession of an equivalent secondary school diploma; OR
- Successful completion of a formal apprenticeship or practical training program in security, asset protection, or law enforcement; OR

- An acceptable equivalent combination of education, specialized training, and practical experience as approved by the Public Service Commission
