JOB PURPOSE: The Agroforestry Extension Officers will work under the overall guidance of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Commerce and under the direct supervision of the Chief of Forestry. The Agroforestry Extension Officers will also help the forestry division to implement the objectives and activities under the RMI Forest Action Plan.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Promote tree planting and Climate Change
2. Train and Assist local communities
3. Help manage and operate the Community Nursery
4. Monitor and treat plant pests and disease
5. Work with local leaders to implement forestry plans
6. Maintain tools and equipment
7. Perform other related duties assigned by the Chief of Forestry

- 1.2 Promote awareness in the Communities and Schools on Forest Management
- 2.1 Assist in training of locals in management of nurseries

- 3.1 Oversee the running and operation of the community nursery
- 3.2 Sustain the operation of the community nursery
- 4.1 Monitor crops and other plants for pests and disease and apply necessary treatment
- 4.2 Ensure that trees planted are well maintained and received proper security
- 5.1 Liaise with local mayor, community and traditional leaders to ensure smooth running and implementation of the Forest Action Plan

- 5.2 Provided technical assistance to the responsible organizations, villages, and individuals
- 5.3 Extension Officer's capacity enhanced and to be shared with communities
- 5.4 Ensure sufficient supply of equipment, tools and other supplies for the community
- 6.1 Maintain the equipment, tools and supplies provided by and through the Ministry of Natural Resources & Commerce
- 7.1 Ensure that the Chief of Forestry is fully aware of the agriculture extension program and activities
- 7.2 Participate in other activities as required by the Chief of Forestry
- 7.3 Carry out other duties as required by the Chief of Forestry
