**JOB PURPOSE:** To provide Medical Laboratory Technology Services for the Ministry of Health & Human Services.

**KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Ensure accurate records and reports and other statistical information for files or databases. Follow laboratory policy for data retrieval, record keeping, specimen, and identification, requisition, reporting, charting, and billing procedures.
2. Perform administrative task in relation to laboratory work.
3. Perform other duties within the capacity, qualification and experience normally expected from person occupying position as this classification.

**MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:**

- 1.1 Record and report data on lab work provided TB patients for maintenance of data collection for review and use program management; records and report date required by the Global Fund to monitor the implementation of Global Fund activities and services in the RMI.
- 1.2 Attend meetings for staff assigned to TB and HIVS/AIDS program to further discuss measures necessary to improve laboratory services; assist in preparation of reports from the hospital and public health laboratories to review progress made and needs for improvement of laboratory services.
- 1.3 Travel to the outer islands as part of health teams to provide laboratory services to TB and HIV/AIDS programs; conduct outreach programs and activities as part of health teams to increase community awareness and participation

1.4 Attend training sessions required by the MOH to improve skills and work performance; develop and implement an inventory system to keep track of supplies and medical supplies required by the hospital laboratory to provide services to TB and HIV/AIDS programs.
