JOB PURPOSE: To improve the immunization coverage for the children in the communities and schools

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Provide Data for Immunization
2. Daily Direct Observation Treatment (DOT)
3. Attend Health Education and Promotion Program
4. Develop system for the MCH patients
5. Perform other duties within the capacity, qualification and experience normally expected from person occupying position as this classification

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1 Collect, Compile, and submit accurate immunization data from fixed, outreach and mobile sessions
- 2.1 To assist the Nurse Supervisor for non-communicable diseases and to assist other public nurse implement a sound immunization program in the outer islands
- 3.1 Observe patients taking their prescribed medications daily to ensure adherence to treatment
- 4.1 Assist in implementing health promotion activities and campaign in the community

- 4.2 Ensure principals in all schools are keeping up with the immunization records of each
- 5.1 Design and implement a system for registering, tracking, and monitoring MCH patients, including mothers and children
- 6.1 Perform other duties as assigned by the Director of Immunization or Chief Nurse, PH

- High School graduate or can Read and Write in English and Marshallese and completed at least 3-4 months' apprenticeship training program or two (2) years equivalent experience or 9 months of apprenticeship training in the related field
