JOB PURPOSE: To maintain and improve patients' oral health by preventing, diagnosing, and treating while promoting good dental hygiene and overall well-being.

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1 Perform detailed visual, tactile, and diagnostic examinations of the oral cavity utilizing state-of-the-art clinical instruments to evaluate overall patient conditions
- 1.2 Review, analyze, and document comprehensive medical and dental histories to isolate systemic risks, contraindications, and drug interactions before starting treatments
- 1.3 Formulate specialized, evidence-based clinical diagnoses and construct tailored treatment plans aligned safely with the approved Dental Officer Scope of work
- 2.1 Execute scaling, root planning, and professional teeth polishing procedures to eliminate plaque, calculus, and surface stains to preserve periodontal health
- 2.2 Administer professional topical fluoride applications and sealants over deep pits or fissure zones to minimize caries risk in vulnerable pediatric and adult patient populations

- 3.1 Treat dental caries by preparing cavities and placing long-lasting composite or amalgam restorative fillings to re-establish structural integrity
- 3.2 Diagnose, design, and deliver dental prosthetics to restore proper masticatory function and enhanced aesthetic outcomes for partially or fully edentulous individuals
- 3.3 Carry out routine surgical tooth extractions safely, managing local anesthesia delivery, soft tissue handling, and post-operative bleeding control

- 4.1 Provide immediate clinical triage and swift management for acute oral conditions, severe dental pain, cellulitis, localized infections, and maxillofacial trauma
- 4.2 Perform urgent surgical interventions and therapeutic extractions under emergency conditions to achieve instant pain relief, limit systemic infection propagation, and prevent life-threatening complications
- 5.1 Record real-time, objective data covering clinical findings, precise diagnostic imaging notes, detailed treatment workflows, and pharmaceutical prescriptions
- 5.2 Protect patient privacy and uphold professional continuity of care by strictly aligning all health data management protocols with MOHHS legal and regulatory mandates
- 6.1 Orchestrate Public education initiatives, community outreach programs, and target awareness campaigns to instill proactive, preventive oral hygiene behaviors
- 6.2 Partner with schools, community leaders, and local stakeholders to implement health policies that lessen the overall systemic burden of oral disease within the Marshall Islands
- 7.1 Coordinate routine testing, meticulous sterilization, and mechanical maintenance of dental chairs, hand pieces, and radiography units following strict manufacturer parameters
- 7.2 Supervise biosecurity protocols and strict infection control guidelines to achieve maximum operating uptime and protect patients and clinical staff from cross- contamination
- 8.1 Deliver strategic daily oversight, technical guidance, and operational leadership to Dental Assistants, Therapists, and Technicians
- 8.2 Conduct objective performance monitoring and identify specialized training opportunities to build technical competencies, uplift clinical performance, and foster safe, collaborative environments.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor Degree in Dental Surgery, Doctor of Dental Medicine, or an equivalent dental degree from a recognized University or medical institution; Or
- Valid registration and practicing license from a recognized medical/dental council, with eligibility to practice under local regulations

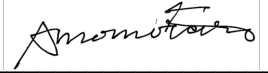
