- 4.1 Gather and report health-related data to local health authorities to inform public health initiatives
- 4.2 Maintain accurate records of community interactions and health education sessions

5.1 Work closely with healthcare providers, NGOs, and community organizations to coordinate services

5.2 Participate in community health programs and initiatives aimed at improving overall health outcomes.

6.1 Advocate for the health needs of the community, ensuring that voices are heard in health policy discussions

6.2 Empower community members to take an active role in their health and wellness


