JOB PURPOSE: Produce and present to the listener on a daily basis continuity program of song and music, general information, commercial messages, government notices and messages, current affairs, and other programs in accordance with V7AB programs policy and music format. Records and translates educational and instructional programs for broadcast.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Research and Information Gathering

4. Station Programming and Continuity
5. Production and Media Editing

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1 Research topics of public interest, current affairs, and local issues to gather material for comments, discussions, and program inputs prior to going on the air.
- 2.1 Present music, local and international news, sports updates, weather reports, correct time announcements, commercials, and essential shipping and airline schedules according to the station roster
- 3.1 Meet regularly with the Program Director and station colleagues to review broadcasting schedules, coordinate daily timelines, and secure specific broadcast event details.
- 4.1 Announce operational station information, including upcoming program schedules, station breaks, commercial advertisements, and public service announcements to maintain a professional broadcast flow.

- 5.1 Edit, rewrite, and translate pre-recorded educational programs and news feeds from external networks—such as the Voice of America (VOA) and Armed Forces Radio and Television Services (AFRTS)—utilizing standard station techniques to assist V7AB staff and contributors.

DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS:

Qualifications:

- Associate degree in a related field, OR a High School Graduate with the completion of at least nine (9) months of an apprenticeship training program and two (2) years of relevant experience or any equivalent combination of education and experience acceptable to the Public Service Commission will also be considered.

- Advanced research ability
- Strong interpersonal skills with the ability to draw information from interviewees
- Ability to maintain composure under pressure and react quickly in a live broadcast environment
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
