JOB PURPOSE: To Government of the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) seeks to increase its capacity to manage deported citizens returning from foreign jurisdictions, improve interagency coordination, and strengthen national security and public safety. TO support this mandate, the Office of National Security (ONS) will establish a Deportees Coordinator position. This position is funded for the upcoming calendar year, with the option for continuation contingent on demonstrated need and the availability of funds during the next national budget cycle in summer 2026. The temporary funding structure reflects both the urgency of the national security concern and the government’s commitment to evaluating long-term sustainability

The Deportees Coordinator will serve as a central point of contact for all matters involving incoming deportees, working closely with RMI ministries, law enforcement agencies, service providers, and community stakeholders. The Deportees Coordinator will manage case information, help assess risks, organize support services, and ensure compliance with RMI national security standards and reporting requirements.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Coordination and Case Management
2. Risk Assessment and Security Oversight
3. Interagency, Taskforce and International Coordinator
4. Policy, Reporting and Compliance
5. Employment, Training and Economic Reintegration
6. Community Engagement and Diaspora Support

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1 Maintain and Comprehensive database of all deportee’s cases, including personal details, criminal histories, risk assessments, and status updates
- 1.2 Conduct initial intake interviews and develop individualized reintegration plan, including referrals for housing, employment assistance, counselling, and health services

- 2.1 Conduct risk assessments for returning deportees to identify potential threats to public safety or national security
- 2.2 Track and Monitor the status of deportee’s post-arrival and provide recommendations regarding monitoring needs, service referrals, or law enforcement coordination
- 3.1 Assist the Deportees Taskforce and its Chair, helping coordinate GRMI entities in their support, planning, and response to deportee-related issues
- 3.2 Facilitate regular Taskforce communication, prepare briefing materials, monitor follow-up actions, and support interagency problem-solving
- 4.1 Develop/ update national policies or standard operating procedures relating to deportees
- 4.2 Prepare regular reports on cases, trends, risks, reintegration outcomes, and agency needs
- 5.1 Work with public and private sector partners, including the Chamber of Commerce, National Training Center, and the College of the Marshall Islands (CMI), to identify job opportunities, vocational training, apprenticeships, and re-education pathways for return citizens
- 5.2 Assist deportees in accessing workforce readings programs, adult education courses, and skills certification opportunities
- 5.3 Support the development of new reintegration-focused employment initiatives, including public- private collaborations and community- based economic projects
- 6.1 Conduct outreach to families, community leaders, and local organizations to facilitate reintegration and ensure community safety
- 6.2 Work with Marshallese diaspora communities abroad on strategies to avoid deportation and facilitate connections with immigration legal aid providers
- 6.3 Identify and develop mechanisms to support Marshallese families in the RMI and aboard who have been affected by the deportation or return of a family member

DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS:

Qualifications:

- Graduated from recognized University with a Bachelor Degree in Criminal Justice, Social Work, Public Administration and International Relations or a related field
- At least 3 years of professional experience in case management, law enforcement, social services, corrections, immigration, or security- related work

Skills:

- Ability to speak Marshallese (highly preferred) and English Fluently
- Strong understanding of criminal justice systems, reintegration processes, and public safety coordination
- Demonstrated ability to work with sensitive information and maintain strict confidentiality
- Excellent communication skills, including report writing and interagency coordination
- Experience working with deportee populations, offender reintegration, or national security functions
- Knowledge of RMI government systems, cultural dynamics, and community structures,
- Training in risk assessments, crisis intervention, or case management frameworks
