- 2.2 Maintain responsibilities for cargo handling and vessel operations while at sea and in port

- 3.2 Oversee vessel safety, maintenance, and operational readiness
- 3.3 Ensure adequate supplies are on board, including water, food, life jackets, and safety equipment
- 4.1 Ensure medical personnel are available during emergency and medical evaluation trips

4.2 Ensure that medical staff are on 24/7 recall for emergency operations

- Valid Seafarer medical certificate
