- 2.2 Operate, inspect, and maintain specialized meteorological instruments and equipment to ensure reliable data collection
- 3.1 Prepare weather forecasts, warnings, advisories, and briefings based on observed and analyzed data
- 3.2 Communicate meteorological information effectively, both orally and in writing, to the general public and specialized user groups
- 4.1 Perform assigned duties independently with minimal supervision while following established guidelines

- 4.2 Work effectively as part of a team to support overall Weather Service operations
- 5.1 Carry out additional related duties as required to support the mission and operations of the Weather Service Office
