**JOB PURPOSE:** To provide strategic leadership and oversight of government-wide cybersecurity by establishing policies, managing cyber risks, coordinating incident response, ensuring compliance with applicable laws and standards, and strengthening national cybersecurity resilience

4.1 Conduct regular cybersecurity risk assessments and vulnerability evaluations across government entities.

5.1 Lead the development, implementation, and review of the National Cybersecurity Strategy

5.2 Ensure cybersecurity initiatives align with national security priorities and digital transformation objectives
