4.1 Adhering to all safety rules, guidelines, and traffic laws, and setting up work-site safety measures like barricades and cones.

5.1 Maintaining accurate daily logs and reports of work performed, materials used, and equipment status or malfunctions.

6.1 Performing general manual labor tasks when not operating equipment, such as using hand and power tools (shovels, rakes, saws, jackhammers).

7.1 Perform other duties assigned.
